No.KP-11 -2011/PRR/102003-145-D: In exercise of the powers conferred by section 227 read with section 274 of the Gujarat Panchayats Act, 1993 (Guj.18 of 1993), the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Multi Purpose Health Worker (Male) in the superior panchayat service, Class-III, namely:-


1. These rules may be called the Multi Purpose Health Worker (Male), Class III, (Panchayat Service) Recruitment Rules, 2011.
2. Appointment to the post of Multi Purpose Health Worker (Male), in the superior panchayat service, Class-III shall be made by direct selection.
3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,-
  - (a) not be less than 18 years of age and not be more than 26 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit shall not be applicable in case of a candidate who is working as a multi-purpose health worker either on contract basis on fixed pay on adhoc basis in regular pay scale on the date of publication of this notification and who possesses the qualifications as prescribed in sub-rules (b),(c) and (d) of this rule and who offers his candidature in respect of advertisement published in the year 2011,

- (b) have passed Secondary School Certificate Examination from Gujarat Secondary Education Board or an equivalent qualification recognized as such by the Government;
- (c) possess the basic Knowledge of Computer Application as prescribed in Gujarat Civil Services Classification and recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

- (d) have successfully completed one year training of Multi Purpose Health Worker basic Course from the institution recognized by the Government, or have passed the Sanitary Inspector Examination from the institution recognized by the Government.
- (e) Possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi, or both.
4. The selected candidate shall be on probation for a period of one year.
  5. A selected candidate shall during his probation period, require to pass the qualifying examination for Computer Knowledge in accordance with the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
  6. The selected candidate shall require to pass an examination in Gujarati or Hindi or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
  7. A selected candidate shall have to undergo such training and to pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
  8. The selected candidate shall require to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time.

Provided that the upper age limit shall not be applicable in case of a candidate who is working as a Multi Purpose Health Worker (Male), Class III, in the Panchayat Service either on contract basis on fixed pay or on adhoc basis in regular pay scale on the date of publication of this notification and who possesses the qualifications as prescribed in clauses (b), (c) and (d) of this rule and who offers his candidature in respect of advertisement which may be published in the year 2014;”.

Provided that the upper age limit shall not be applicable in case of a candidate who is appointed as a Multi Purpose Health Worker (Male), Class III, on contract basis on fixed pay for a fixed period or on adhoc basis in regular pay-scale but for a fixed period and who possesses the qualifications as prescribed in clauses (b), (c) and (d) of this rule and who offers his candidature in respect of advertisement which may be published in the year 2016;"
