GUJARAT PANCHAYATS ACT, 1993

No. KP/01/2014/PRR/102013/1897-KH.— In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (5) of section 227 read with section 274 of the Gujarat Panchayats Act, 1993 (Guj.18 of 1993), and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Deputy Chitnis, Class III, in the Superior Panchayat Service, namely :-

1. These rules may be called the Deputy Chitnis, Class III, in the Superior Panchayat Service Recruitment Rules, 2013.
2. Appointment to the post of Deputy Chitnis, Class III, in the Superior Panchayat Service shall be made, either,
 - (a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons, who-
 - (i) have worked for not less than five years in the cadre of Senior Clerk or Store Keeper class III, in the Superior Panchayat service;
 - (ii) have passed the prescribed departmental examination; and
 - (iii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006:

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in sub-clause (i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period; it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified in sub-clause (i) above; or

(b) by direct selection.

3. The appointment by direct selection and promotion shall be made in the ratio of 1:3.

4. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall -

(a) not be less than 18 years and more than 30 years of age:

Provide that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the Gujarat Panchayat Service in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Panchayat Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules,1998:

Provide further that the upper age limit may be released in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules,1967;

(b) possess -

(i) a bachelor's degree obtained from any of the University established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared as deemed to be a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act,1956; or an equivalent qualification recognized by the Government;

(ii) the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules,1967;

(iii) adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.

5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of one year.

6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, require to undergo pre-service training and pass the post-training examination in accordance with the rules as may be prescribed by the Government.

7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, require to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.

8. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to pass the departmental examination and an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.

9. The candidate appointed either by direct selection or by promotion shall have to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.

10. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
