**RESOLUTION**

Government of India is giving a special thrust on empowerment of SCs/STs and women in the 12<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan. Formulation and implementation of the Scheduled Caste Sub-plan(SCSP), Tribal Sub-plan(TSP) and Gender Budgeting are an integral part of the central planning process. Accordingly, Government of India, Department of Electronics and Information Technology (DeitY) has launched the Scheme for IT Mass Literacy with the objective of providing IT training to total of 10 lakh persons across the country which will include beneficiaries from eligible households of every village in selected blocks in each State/UT. This is keeping in view the objective of the National policy on IT 2012 – to make one person in every household IT literate.

2. The main objective of the programme is to provide IT training to 10 lakh persons in every eligible household in selected blocks in each State/UT relevant to the need of the trainee, which would enable the beneficiaries to use IT and related applications to participate effectively in the democratic process and enhance their livelihood.
3. As per the scheme, the State Government of Gujarat has been categorized under category "A" and 60,000 number of persons to be trained spread across 5-7 districts of Gujarat. The scheme will be implemented by CSC e-Governance Service India limited.
4. The Scheme is funded by Department of Electronics and Information Technology (DeitY), Government of India, and 5% of the training cost will be given to the State Implementing Agency.
5. The e-Gram Vishavgram Society under Panchayats Rural Housing & Rural Development Department, State Government of Gujarat is designated as State Implementing agency for this scheme in Gujarat State.


**7. District Level Committee:-**
